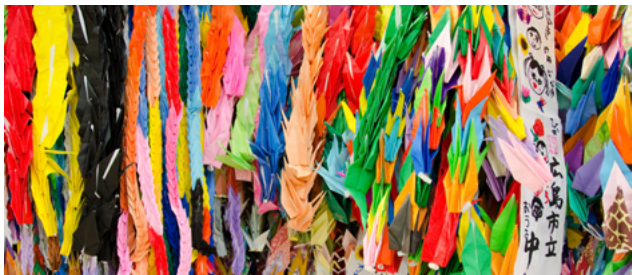

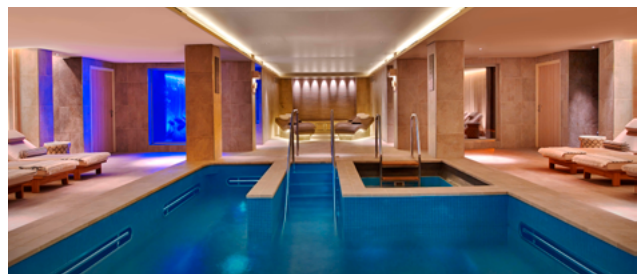

You will then visit the Nagasaki Peace Park, pausing to contemplate the power of the Peace Statue and the Fountain of Peace.

Its dramatic 50-foot-tall, red-orange torii gate is distinctive. The shrine complex consists of multiple buildings. Enjoy some time to explore the island at your leisure. **OPTIONAL**



## SHIRAITO FALLS & FUJISAN HONGŪ SENGEN TAISHA SHIMIZU, JAPAN

The sacred Shiraito Falls are part of UNESCO's World Heritage Site designation for Mt. Fuji. Admire their natural beauty as thin white streams resembling hanging threads of silk cascade from 65 feet above your head across a 500-foot-wide rock face. Visit the Fujisan Hongū Sengen Taisha—a grand Shinto shrine and traditional starting point for pilgrims hiking up the mountain. **OPTIONAL**

## HIGHLIGHTS OF TAIPEI TAIWAN, PROVINCE OF CHINA

Visit the iconic Taipei 101 tower, one of the world's tallest buildings. Learn about Taiwan's political history with a photo stop at the National Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall. Explore the Taiwan Handicraft Centre, where you will have free time to browse traditional crafts before traveling to the colourful Bao-An Temple. **OPTIONAL**

## AN EVENING IN TOKYO JAPAN

Admire Tokyo at night with a visit to the Tokyo Skytree — the highest stand-alone broadcasting tower in the world — and take in the breathtaking views. Later, enjoy a scenic drive over the Sumida River to the Asakusa district, once Tokyo's leading entertainment district, then through the Ginza district, the centre of modern Tokyo. **OPTIONAL**

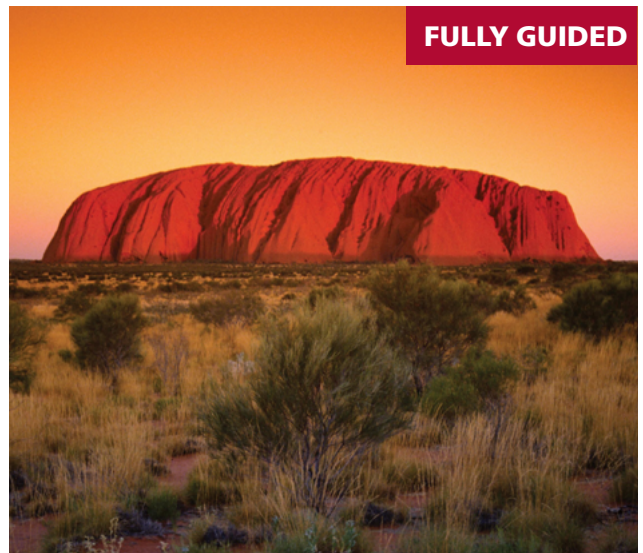
