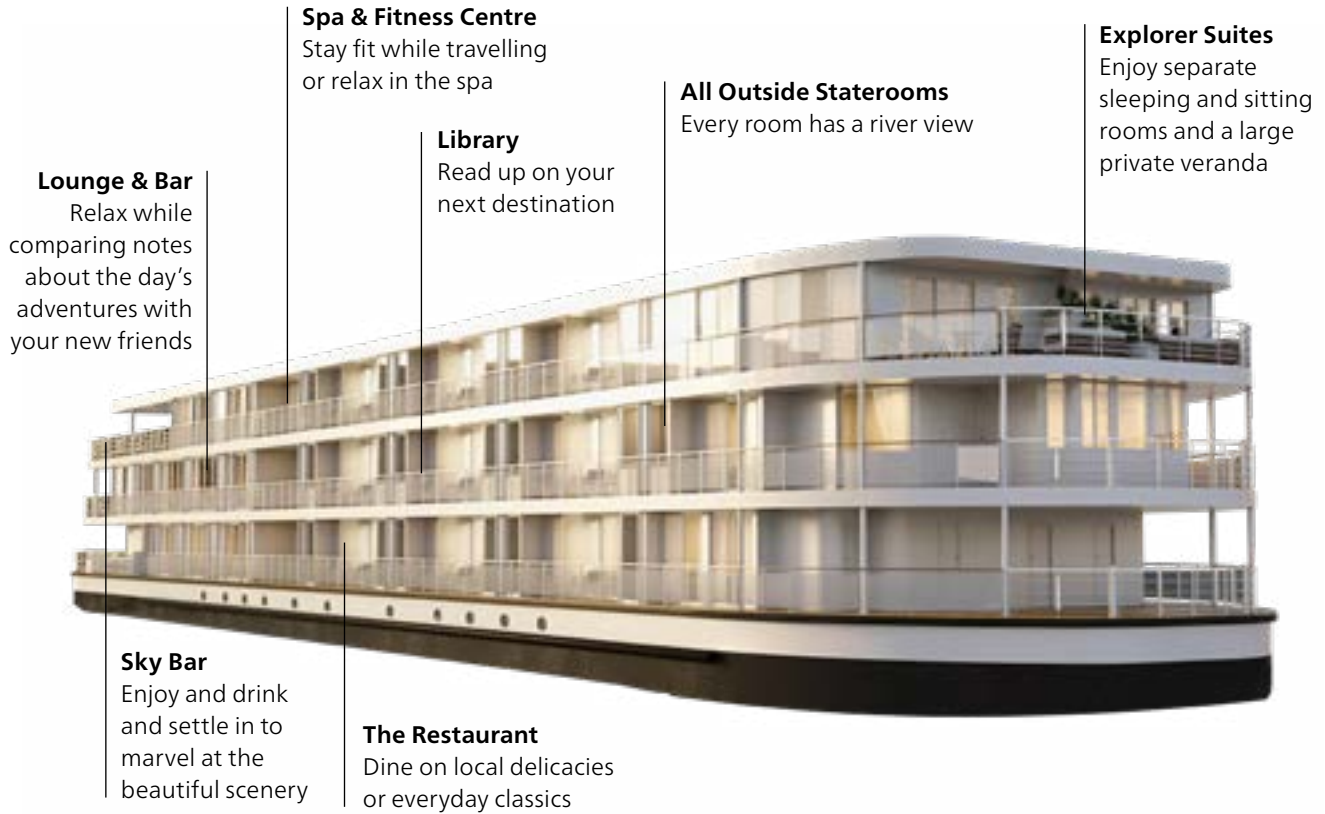

OLD DELHI BY PEDAL CAB

INDIA

Visit the Raj Ghat, a memorial dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi. Continue toward the heart of Old Delhi, where you will board a rickshaw. Glimpse market stalls displaying spices, colourful fabrics and jewellery. Visit Humayun's Tomb, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. **INCLUDED**

SUNSET AT THE TAJ MAHAL

AGRA, INDIA

Meet your guide and set off for the Taj Mahal to see its impressive architecture, watching as its marble exterior reflects the hues of golden hour. As you explore, note the Indian, Persian and Islamic influences in its designs and discover the lush gardens and central pool. **INCLUDED**

FATEHPUR SIKRI

THE HIGHLIGHTS OF GUWAHATI

INDIA

Explore 9th century Kamakhya Temple, which is dedicated to the eponymous goddess. Walk to the local market to see colourful fruits, silks and local food displayed. Visit the Brahmaputra River Heritage Centre with historical artifacts and traditional textiles that demonstrate its impact on trade, local life and folklore. **INCLUDED**

WESTERN RANGE SAFARI

Explore the open plains of one of India's best known national parks to spot the Great Indian One-Horned Rhino. Keep watch for an array of wildlife, including water buffalo, elephants and the diverse range of birds. **INCLUDED**

Set out to discover the myriad cultures of one of the world's largest river islands. Glimpse the stilted homes a pause along the way to learn about local crafts, such as silk weaving and the art of making Mukha Shilpa, or masks that depict key figures in Hindu scripture that are used in religious plays. **INCLUDED**

2 NIGHTS IN DELHI

Journey to India's capital, New Delhi, and Delhi, a historic seat of power. Discover Mahatma Gandhi's legacy at his final residence and visit the Lotus Temple, an architectural feat. Discover India's rich heritage at the Crafts Museum, where several centuries of art and handicrafts are displayed.



5 NIGHTS IN COCHIN & MUMBAI

Discover the coast of southwestern India, experience Cochin's rich cultural history and explore Kerala's network of canals and lagoons to glimpse life along the river. Travel to Mumbai to learn of its storied past and visit the Elephanta Caves, an ancient Hindu worship site.



3 NIGHTS IN DUBAI

Discover Dubai's towering buildings and intriguing past. Ascend the Burj Khalifa, the world's tallest skyscraper, and mingle with locals at the gold and spice markets. Glimpse the intricate Islamic designs of Abu Dhabi's Sheik Zayed Grand Mosque and enjoy Arabian hospitality at a desert camp.
