Uncover the wonders of marine life at the Alaska SeaLife Centre in Seward or learn about the enduring legacy of dog sledding and the Iditarod. In Juneau and Skagway, trace the legacy of the Gold Rush, while Icy Strait Point and Valdez offer unforgettable wildlife encounters.

SHORE EXCURSIONS ON YOUR JOURNEY

WHITE PASS SUMMIT BY VINTAGE RAIL CAR **SKAGWAY, USA**

Retrace the steps of the Yukon's fortune seekers in their 19th-century quest for gold. Travel by vintage rail car and marvel at scenic mountain vistas as you climb along Alaska's White Pass summit. See the original Klondike Trail of 1898 worn into the rocks, a reminder of those who traversed this route in search of gold. **OPTIONAL**

SPASSKI RIVER VALLEY WILDLIFE & BEAR SEARCH **ICY STRAIT POINT, USA**

The Spasski River Valley is famous for having one of the highest densities of coastal brown bears per square mile in the world. Explore Alaska's natural beauty and keep your eyes peeled for bald eagles and Sitka black-tailed deer as your guide shows you where to look, and explains more about the animals' habitat. **OPTIONAL**

HIGHLIGHTS OF VALDEZ **USA**

Embark on a panoramic drive, learning about the town's gold-rush era and visiting Old Town Valdez. You will also hear stories about more contemporary pivotal moments such as the Good Friday earthquake of 1964 and the Exxon Valdez oil spill in 1989. Stop for photos at Horsetail and Bridal Veil Falls, their snow and icy meltwaters cascading over towering canyon walls from hundreds of feet above. **OPTIONAL**

ALASKA SEALIFE CENTRE **SEWARD, USA**

Admire the species in the public aquarium and learn about the research animals in the exhibit tanks. North Pacific mammals, birds, fish and invertebrates are profiled in the centre's comprehensive displays. **INCLUDED**

RESURRECTION BAY WILDLIFE CRUISE **SEWARD, USA**

Explore the protected waters and rugged coast of Resurrection Bay on board an exclusive Viking chartered vessel. Head out for an opportunity to experience up-close encounters with wildlife. 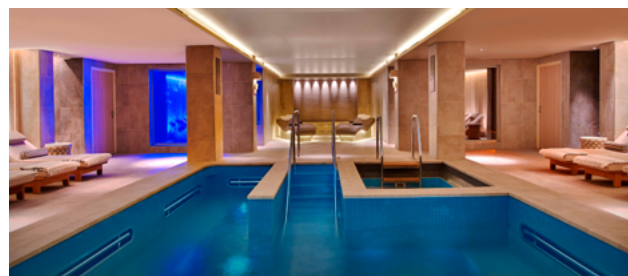

SAPPORO HIGHLIGHTS

JAPAN

Drive with your guide into the picturesque city of Sapporo and visit the Hokkaidō Shrine. Step back in time to the island's frontier days at the Historical Village of Hokkaidō. Featuring buildings from the mid-19th to early 20th century, this open-air museum showcases the industries, lifestyles and culture of the times. **INCLUDED**

NIGHTTIME VISTAS FROM ATOP MT. TENGU SAPPORO, JAPAN

Mt. Tengu's steep-sided stratovolcano's peak stands at more than 8,600 feet above sea level, offering sweeping views. Board a cable car for a 4-minute ride to the observatory. Gaze out over the city, its network of lit streets and buildings stretching toward the dark waters of the gulf. Enjoy coffee or tea and snacks at the on-site café. **OPTIONAL**

SLED DOGS OF THE IDITAROD SEWARD, ALASKA

Dogsledding traces its roots back to around 1000 AD; it became a vital method of transportation for the north Canadian Inuit people. Transfer to the homestead of your hosts, where you will meet your guide and your eager huskies. Take a seat in your wheel-equipped sled, then set off into the wilderness on a drive into the Advent Valley. **OPTIONAL**



HIGHLIGHTS OF VALDEZ ALASKA, USA

OVERNIGHT IN BUENOS AIRES

Argentina's cosmopolitan capital, is an eclectic combination of Latin and European influences. Enjoy even more time to explore this city's many cafés, bodegas and vibrant nightlife. Visit Casa Rosada, a major landmark on Plaza de Mayo.

SHORE EXCURSIONS ON YOUR JOURNEY

TANGO SHOW & LUNCH BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA

Tango mixes African rhythms and European music to create an expressive dance where partners maintain harmony and connection with each other and the music. You will have an opportunity to admire all the qualities of tango in its different expressions—singers and dancers as well as a tango orchestra—while enjoying a delicious meal. **OPTIONAL**

EMERALD LAKE CRUISE, PETROHUÉ FALLS & PUERTO VARAS PUERTO MONTT, CHILE

Embark on a 45-minute cruise on All Saints Lake, also known as the Emerald Lake. At Petrohué Rapids, you will see a gleaming succession of blue rapids against a backdrop of mountains, including the nearby Osorno volcano. Walk the pathways and trails, taking in the stunning views. After, drive to Puerto Varas where a delicious local lunch will be served.

OPTIONAL

DISCOVER MONTEVIDEO & CARNIVAL MUSEUM URUGUAY

Take a panoramic drive to Independence Square. See the monument dedicated to national hero José Gervasio Artigas, the Government House and the Solís Theatre. Equally impressive is the Batlle y Ordóñez Park, the Constituents' Obelisk and the Centenario Stadium. Visit the Carnival Museum, admire the exhibits and enjoy a lively performance of murga. **INCLUDED**



PANORAMIC TIERRA DEL FUEGO BY LAND & SEA USHUAIA, ARGENTINA

Embark on the antique wagons of the Ferrocarril Austral Fueguino for a leisurely steam-powered locomotive trip across the Pipo River and the Cañadón del Toro before entering Tierra del Fuego National Park. Then board a catamaran and set sail toward the Beagle Channel's coastal islands.

OPTIONAL

PENGUINS OF BLUFF COVE LAGOON PORT STANLEY, FALKLAND ISLANDS

Discover the thriving penguin population and abundant bird species of Bluff Cove Lagoon, a private wildlife haven. Set against the scenic backdrop of a large lagoon and white-sand beaches, this pristine nature reserve is home to more than 1,000 breeding pairs of gentoo penguins and a growing colony of king penguins. **OPTIONAL**

VALPARAÍSO & MUSEUMS SANTIAGO, CHILE

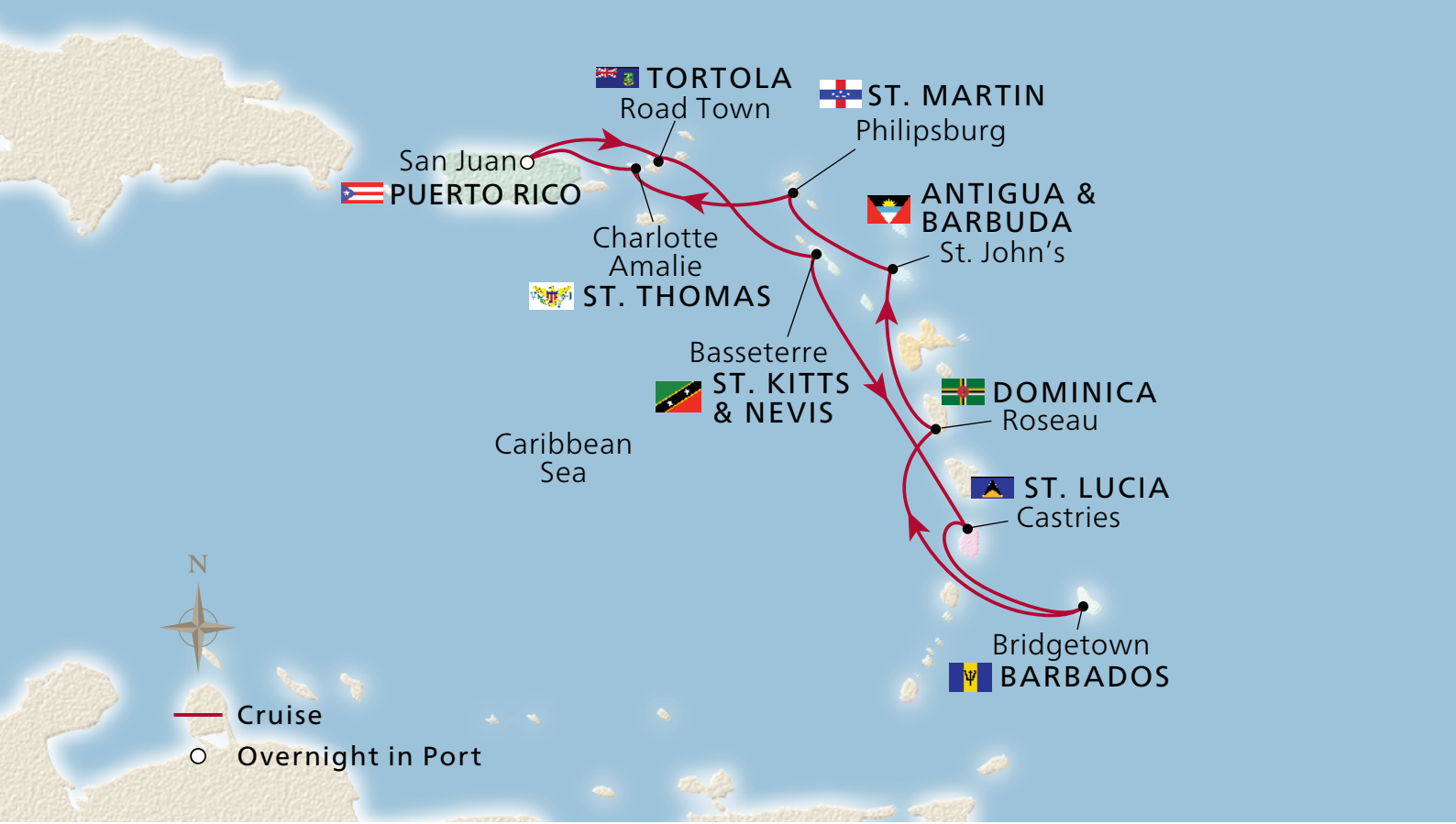
